ORDINANCE NO.: 20-O-21

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE “2020 LAKE COUNTY ROAD IMPROVEMENT AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT GRANT,” AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Lake County, Ohio have declared that quality road infrastructure is critical to economic development opportunities and provide for a high standard of living for Lake County’s residents; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Lake County, Ohio have passed a resolution on December 19, 2019 authorizing a one-time \$1,500,000 grant to Lake County Communities for road improvement projects included in their Capital Improvement Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City of Kirtland has been allocated to receive \$52,505.57 from this one-time grant for road infrastructure improvements within the City; and

WHEREAS, the City of Kirtland has a Capital Improvement Plan outlining the maintenance and improvement projects for various roads within the City; and

WHEREAS, the City of Kirtland desires to accept the one-time grant from the Board of Commissioners of Lake County, Ohio to help fund the Springer Drive/Circle pavement improvement project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Kirtland, County of Lake and State of Ohio, that:

SECTION I: The City of Kirtland hereby accepts the “2020 Lake County Road Improvement and Economic Development Grant,” awarding \$52, 505.57 from the Board of Commissioners of Lake County, Ohio.

SECTION II: The receipt of said funds shall be applied towards the total cost of the Springer Drive/Circle pavement improvement project. Said project is included in the City’s Capital Improvement Plan. Said project shall encompass improvement of the pavement of said roadway, up to and including replacement. Initial cost estimates for the entire project exceed \$53,000.00. The completion of Springer Drive/Circle shall be completed on or before December 31, 2020.

SECTION III:

(a) It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were passed in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings

open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

(b) This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City, and for the reason for the emergency is to ensure prompt receipt of funds to improve the city's road infrastructure and to accept the one-time grant money; wherefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the affirmative vote of five (5) members of Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise this Ordinance shall be in effect from and after its adoption at the earliest period allowed by law.
