RESOLUTION NUMBER 21-R-46

**A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE APPOINTMENT OF
RICK LOCONTI AS THE ZONING INSPECTOR FOR THE
CITY OF KIRTLAND, AND DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the Mayor and members of City Council have conducted a review of the zoning inspector position, including the necessary qualifications, salaries and benefits, and prospective duties; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and members of City Council conducted interviews of candidates and have worked collaboratively to choose a candidate for the position of a part-time zoning inspector; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Kirtland Charter Article II (7) and Kirtland Code of Ordinances §1262.01 (a) and (b) the Mayor has appointed Rick Loconti for the part-time position of Zoning Inspector for the City of Kirtland; and

WHEREAS, the City Council agrees to confirm the appointment pursuant to Kirtland Code of Ordinances §1262.01 (b); and

WHEREAS, Rick Loconti agrees to accept the position of Zoning Inspector.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Kirtland, County of Lake and State of Ohio, that:

SECTION I: The Mayor's appointment of Rick Loconti to the part-time position of Zoning Inspector for the City of Kirtland be, and hereby is, confirmed and shall commence October 1, 2021.

SECTION II: Rick Loconti agrees to accept the position as Zoning Inspector with the City of Kirtland. Said duties shall include, but are not limited to, those found in the Kirtland Code of Ordinances § 1262.01. The Zoning Inspector will have a City vehicle available for use while traveling for zoning purposes in the City as well as a laptop computer for zoning work.

SECTION III: Loconti agrees to accept this part-time position at the pay rate of \$38.00 per hour, not to exceed 20 hours per week, 46 weeks per year. LoConti agrees that this position will not entitle him to any medical insurance benefits. Loconti further agrees to attend Planning & Zoning Commission meetings at no extra charge. Additionally, if requested, Loconti

agrees to attend any Board of Zoning Appeals or Council meetings and will be compensated at his above-described hourly rate.

SECTION V:

(a) It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were passed in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

(b) This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City, and for the further reason that it is necessary to provide for the usual and customary operations of the City, particularly its zoning office. Therefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the affirmative vote of five (5) members of Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise this Resolution shall be in effect from and after its adoption at the earliest period allowed by law.
