RESOLUTION NUMBER 21-R-50

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE AMOUNTS AND RATES AS DETERMINED BY THE BUDGET COMMISSION AND AUTHORIZING THE NECESSARY TAX LEVIES AND CERTIFYING THEM TO THE COUNTY AUDITOR.

WHEREAS, this Council in accordance with the provisions of law has previously adopted a Tax Budget for the next succeeding fiscal year commencing January 1, 2022; and

WHEREAS, The Budget Commission of Lake County, Ohio, has certified its action thereon to this Council together with an estimate by the County Auditor of the rate of each tax necessary to be levied by this Council, and what part thereof is without, and what part within, the ten mill tax limitation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Kirtland, County of Lake, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION I: The amounts and rates, as determined by the Budget Commission in its certification, be and the same are hereby accepted; and

SECTION II: That there be and is hereby levied on the tax duplicate of said City the rate of each tax necessary to be levied within and without the ten mill limitation as set forth on **SCHEDULE "A"** titled "Summary of Amounts Required from General Property Tax Approved by Budget Commission, and County Auditors Estimated Tax Rates"; and **SCHEDULE "B"** titled "Levies Outside 10 Mill Limitation, Exclusive of Debt Levies"; both of which schedules are attached hereto, incorporated herein and made a part hereof as though fully set forth herein at length; and

SECTION III: That the Clerk of this Council be and is hereby directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to the County Auditor of said County.

SECTION IV:

(a) It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were passed in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

(b) This Resolution shall be in effect from and after its adoption at the earliest period allowed by law.
