RESOLUTION NUMBER 21-R-70

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE COUNTY AUDITOR TO MAKE ADVANCE PAYMENTS OF TAXES PURSUANT TO OHIO REVISED CODE SECTION 321.34, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Ohio Revised Code allows a taxing authority to request payment from the County Auditor fund derived from taxes or other sources to the County Treasurer, which may be held on account of a local subdivision; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Kirtland, County of Lake and State of Ohio:

SECTION I: That the Auditor and Treasurer of Lake County, in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 321.34, be requested to draw and pay to the City of Kirtland upon the written request of Louis Slapnicker, Finance Director, hereby authorized by the Council of the City of Kirtland, to make said request to the County Auditor, funds derived from taxes or other sources, payable to the County Treasurer to the account of the City of Kirtland, and lawfully applicable for purposes of the current fiscal year, from January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2022.

SECTION II: That the Clerk of Council of the City of Kirtland shall forward to the County Auditor a certified copy of this Resolution.

SECTION III:

(a) It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were passed in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

(b) This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City, and for the further reason that it is necessary to provide for the usual and customary operations of the City of Kirtland; wherefor, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the affirmative vote of five (5) members of Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise this Resolution shall be in effect from and after its adoption at the earliest period allowed by law.
