A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CLOSEOUT OF THE TIBBETS ROAD DRAINAGE PROJECT CONTRACT WITH BADGER TRANSFER LLC, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Kirtland has previously entered into a Contract with Badger Transfer LLC for a drainage project on Tibbets Road; and

WHEREAS, Badger Transfer LLC has successfully completed the Contract; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to complete the closeout procedure.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Kirtland, County of Lake and State of Ohio, that:

SECTION I: The Mayor be and is hereby authorized to accept the credit amount of One Thousand Two Hundred Fifty-Two Dollars and Forty-Six Cents (\$1,252.46). The City Engineer has approved the closeout of the project.

SECTION II: The Director of Finance be and is authorized and instructed to credit the amount provided for in Section 1 of this Resolution upon passage hereof and return said credits to the Lake County, Ohio Stormwater Management pursuant to Section Five of the original Memorandum of Understanding outlining the Duties of the City.

SECTION III: This Council determines that the work included in the Contract with Badger Transfer LLC has been completed and the Contract may be closed out with a final project cost of Forty-Four Thousand Seven Hundred Forty-Seven Dollars and Fifty-Four Cents (\$44,747.54).

SECTION IV: The Mayor be and is hereby authorized to execute all documents necessary to complete the closeout of this contract in accordance with this Resolution.
