## **RESOLUTION NUMBER 22-R-50**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CLOSEOUT OF THE CONTRACT WITH SPECIALIZED CONSTRUCTION, INC. FOR ITS WORK ON SECTIONS I THROUGH IIA OF THE 2021 PAVEMENT REHABILITATION PROJECT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

**WHEREAS,** the City of Kirtland has previously entered into a Contract with Specialized Construction, Inc. for work performed pursuant to Sections I through IIA of the 2021 Pavement Rehabilitation Project for the total cost of \$1,880,079.95; and

**WHEREAS,** the City had previously passed 22-R-11 which was a change order reduction, bring the total contract cost to \$1,644,452.33, a reduction of \$235,627.72.

**WHEREAS,** Specialized Construction, Inc. has successfully completed the terms of the Contract for the total cost of \$1,631,192.18, a reduction of \$13,260.05 from the previously approved final change order; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to complete the closeout procedure.

**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Kirtland, County of Lake and State of Ohio, that:

**SECTION I:** This Council hereby determines that the work included in the Contract with Specialized Construction, Inc. has been completed and the Contract may be closed out with a final project cost of One Million Six Hundred Thirty-One Thousand One Hundred Ninety-Two Dollars and Eighteen Cents (\$1,631,192.18), which is a reduction of \$13,260.05 from the previously approved final change order.

**SECTION II:** The Mayor be and is hereby authorized to execute all documents necessary to complete the closeout of this contract in accordance with this Resolution.

## **SECTION III:**

(a) It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were passed in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
