RESOLUTION NUMBER 22-R-44

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE BID OF BARBICAS PAVING LLC, AWARDING SECTIONS I THROUGH IIIA OF THE 2022 PAVEMENT REHABILITATION PROJECT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Kirtland has a duty to maintain public streets and roads within its municipal boundaries; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer and Director of Public Service have outlined various potential projects as outlined in its 2022 Pavement Rehabilitation Project; and

WHEREAS, the City of Kirtland, in compliance with all bidding requirements as found in the Ohio Revised Code, solicited bids for said potential paving projects; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer unsealed and opened various bids relative to the 2022 Pavement Rehabilitation Project on June 21, 2022, has reviewed said bids, and has made a recommendation for acceptance of the bid placed by Barbicas Paving LLC for work to be performed in sections I, IA, II, IIA, III, and IIIA of the 2022 Pavement Rehabilitation Project; and

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Kirtland, County of Lake and State of Ohio, that:

SECTION I: It is hereby determined that the bid of Barbicas Paving LLC, of Akron, Ohio, is the lowest and best bid to perform Sections I, IA, II, IIA, III, and IIIA of the 2022 Pavement Rehabilitation Project. The City of Kirtland hereby accepts the bid of Barbicas Paving LLC for the completion of this project in an amount not to exceed \$1,312,126.65, of which \$1,299,571.65 is allocated towards the line items bid and \$12,555.00 is allocated towards the good faith estimate of construction inspection.

SECTION II: The Mayor or his designee is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract or execute any purchase orders in the furtherance of this Resolution.

SECTION III: The Director of Finance is authorized and instructed to issue such vouchers and expend all funds necessary in the furtherance of this Resolution. Said payments shall

be made from the Street Improvement Fund. However, any expenditures beyond the original bid of \$1,299,571.65 for the line items bid and \$12,555.00 for the good faith estimate of construction inspection shall be subject to further authorization by this Council.

SECTION IV:

(a) It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were passed in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

(b) This resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City, and for the further reason that it is necessary to maintain the streets and roads of the City; therefore, this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the affirmative vote of five (5) members of Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise this resolution shall be in effect from and after its adoption at the earliest period allowed by law.
