## CITY OF KIRTLAND

ORDINANCE NO.: 23-O-13

AN ORDINANCE CREATING FUND 215 TO PROPERLY ACCOUNT FOR THE RECEIPT OF GRANT FUNDING RELATING TO OHIO'S FIRST RESPONDER RECRUITMENT, RETENTION, AND RESILIENCE PROGRAM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

**WHEREAS,** the City has previously passed 22-R-69 wherein it agreed to accept grant funding from the State of Ohio's Emergency Management Agency through the Ohio First Responder Recruitment, Retention, and Resilience Program in an amount up to \$589,060.17 and pledged to hire up to three full-time firefighter/paramedics; and

**WHEREAS,** a separate fund is required to be established under Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.09 to account for the revenue derived from sources other than the general property tax; and

**WHEREAS,** the Director of Finance has tentatively created Fund 215 to properly account for the receipt of said funds and asks this Council to formally create the fund for proper accounting.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Kirtland, County of Lake and State of Ohio, that:

**SECTION I:** This Council hereby authorizes the Director of Finance to create Fund 215 to account for the receipt of grant funding received in accordance with 22-R-69.

## **SECTION II:**

- (a) It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- (b) This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the City, and for the further reason that the fund must be created to properly coincide with the city's annual appropriations; wherefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its
