ORDINANCE NUMBER 23-O-94

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH FAIRSITE TECHNOLOGIES TO PURCHASE A NEW PHONE SYSTEM AND PHONES FOR CITY BUILDINGS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Mayor has determined that the City's current phone system is outdated and in need of replacement; and

WHEREAS, the internet capabilities in the Police, Fire, and Service buildings require new wiring; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor has consulted with Fairsite Technologies for technology assistance and Fairsite Technologies has provided a quote for said services in the amount of \$28,680.00, said quote is attached hereto as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor has reviewed said quote and recommends that this Council authorize him to enter into an agreement with Fairsite Technologies for the purchase of a new phone system and the infrastructure improvements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Kirtland, County of Lake and State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1: The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with Fairsite Technologies for the purchase of a phone system, new phones, and for the necessary infrastructure improvements as outlined in the quote in Exhibit A for a cost not to exceed \$28,680.00.

SECTION 2: The Mayor is hereby authorized to sign any documents to complete the purchase as described herein, and the Director of Finance is hereby authorized to expend the necessary funds to complete the transaction.

SECTION 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were passed in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Kirtland. The emergency is necessary in order to continue providing necessary telephonic and internet services by the City administration, police, fire, and service departments. Therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the affirmative vote of five (5) members of Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise this Ordinance shall be in effect from and after its adoption at the earliest period allowed by law.
