ORDINANCE NO.: 23-O-95

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO ACCEPT A PROPOSAL FOR THE PURCHASE OF COMPREHENSIVE LIABILITY INSURANCE FOR THE CITY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance for the City of Kirtland has solicited proposals for various insurance policy coverages on behalf of the City; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance has recommended that the City accept the proposal from Jackson, Dieken & Associates, Inc. using both U.S. Specialty Insurance Co. and Lloyds CFC for various insurance coverages.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Kirtland, County of Lake, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION I: That the Director of Finance be and hereby is authorized to take all reasonable and necessary steps to accept the proposal from Jackson, Dieken & Associates, Inc. utilizing U.S. Specialty Insurance Co. and Lloyds CFS for various insurance coverages on behalf of the City commencing January 1, 2024 for calendar year 2024. Said proposal is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit A.

SECTION II:

(a) It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were passed in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

(b) This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City, and for the further reason that it is necessary to provide insurance coverage to the City; wherefore, this Ordinance shall be

in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the affirmative vote of five (5) members of Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise this Ordinance shall be in effect from and after its adoption at the earliest period allowed by law.
