## **RESOLUTION NUMBER 23-R-70**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO ACCEPT Α GRANT **FROM** THE OHIO **EMERGENCY** MANAGEMENT AGENCY FOR THE ARPA FIRST RESPONDER RECRUITMENT, RETENTION, AND RESILIENCE PROGRAM, **DECLARING** AND ANEMERGENCY.

**WHEREAS,** the City has submitted an application to the State of Ohio's Emergency Management Agency for grant funding through the Ohio First Responder Recruitment, Retention, and Resilience Program which has been established through ARPA funding; and

**WHEREAS,** the State of Ohio has informed the City that its grant application has been approved, and grant funds in the amount of Sixty Thousand, Nine Hundred Twenty-Nine Dollars and Ninety-Six Cents (\$60,929.96) are available to the City to provide payment to those firefighters who remained employed by the City through the covid pandemic; and

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary to accept said grant.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Kirtland, County of Lake and State of Ohio, that:

**SECTION I:** This Council hereby authorizes the Mayor or his designee to accept a grant from the State of Ohio's First Responder Recruitment, Retention, and Resilience Program for an amount of Sixty Thousand, Nine Hundred Twenty-Nine Dollars and Ninety-Six Cents (\$60,929.96) to provide payment to those firefighters who remained employed by the City through the covid pandemic.

**SECTION II:** The Mayor or his designee is hereby authorized to execute all documents necessary to accept said grant, and all actions taken by the Mayor or his designee to accept said grant prior to the effective date of this Resolution are hereby ratified and approved.
