A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO NEGOTIATE TERMS FOR CITYWIDE BROADBAND INTERNET SERVICES.

WHEREAS, the City has submitted a request for proposal for citywide fiberoptic internet services; and

WHEREAS, the City received proposals from three vendors for internet services; and

WHEREAS, Jim Gibbs, the information technology consultant hired by the City of Kirtland, has reviewed and scored said proposals; and

WHEREAS, the Utilities Standing Committee has met numerous times to review said proposals and query the vendors; and

WHEREAS, the Utilities Standing Committee has issued a recommendation to this Council to authorize the Mayor to negotiate such terms and conditions with Ohio Gig as may be favorable to the City and its residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Kirtland, County of Lake and State of Ohio, that:

SECTION I: This Council hereby authorizes the Mayor or his designee to negotiate various terms and conditions with Ohio Gig for citywide internet services, said terms to be ultimately approved by this Council.

SECTION II:

(a) It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
