RESOLUTION NUMBER 24-R-24

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE BID OF PAT FLOWERS INC. FOR THE STRIPING OF LONG LINES AND PAVEMENT MARKINGS ON THE CITY OF KIRTLAND'S ROADS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Kirtland has a duty to maintain public streets and roads within its municipal boundaries; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with its duty to maintain the streets and roads, the City is in need of a vendor to perform the striping of the long lines and pavement markings; and

WHEREAS, the Service Director for the City of Kirtland solicited quotes for the striping of its long lines and pavement markings on the City's roads; and

WHEREAS, the Service Director has determined the quote of Pat Flowers Inc. was the lowest and best quote for the project and recommends the City's approval of the same.

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Kirtland, County of Lake and State of Ohio, that:

SECTION I: It is hereby determined that the quote from Pat Flowers Inc. of Mentor, Ohio for the striping of long lines and pavement markings is the lowest and best quote for the pavement markings project in the City. Said quote, attached hereto as Exhibit A, shall be pursuant to ODOT specification #642 and #740 and shall be for an amount not to exceed \$39,792.10.

SECTION II: The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to enter into any and all contracts for the purchase of the above road materials and services.

SECTION III: The Director of Finance is authorized and instructed to issue such vouchers and expend all funds necessary in the furtherance of this Resolution. Said payments shall be made from the Road Maintenance Fund. However, any expenditures beyond the original bid of \$39,792.10 shall be subject to further authorization by this Council.

SECTION IV:

(a) It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were passed in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

(b) This resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City, and for the further reason that it is necessary to provide for the usual and daily operations of the City in maintaining the streets and roads of the City; wherefor, this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the affirmative vote of five (5) members of Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise this resolution shall be in effect from and after its adoption at the earliest period allowed by law.
