**CITY OF KIRTLAND**

**RESOLUTION NUMBER 24-R-72**

**A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE BID OF OHIO PAVING AND CONSTRUCTION COMPANY FOR ITS WORK ON THE REPAVING OF THE KIRTLAND COMMUNITY CENTER PARKING LOT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Kirtland has a duty to maintain the paved surfaces of its various city-owned properties; and

**WHEREAS**, the Community Center, located at 7900 Euclid Chardon Road in Kirtland, is in need of having its parking lot repaved; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Kirtland, in compliance with all bidding requirements as found in the Ohio Revised Code, solicited bids for said potential project; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Engineer unsealed and opened various bids relative to the Kirtland Community Center parking lot repaving project on August 30, 2024, has reviewed said bids, and has made a recommendation for acceptance of the bid placed by Ohio Paving and Construction Company for work to be performed in accordance with said bid.

**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Kirtland, County of Lake, and State of Ohio, that:

**SECTION I:** It is hereby determined that the bid of Ohio Paving and Construction Company of Willoughby, Ohio is the lowest and best bid to perform the parking lot repaving project at the Kirtland Community Center. The City of Kirtland hereby accepts the bid of Ohio Paving and Construction Company for the completion of this project in an amount not to exceed \$87,207.46.

**SECTION II:** The Mayor or his designee is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract or execute any purchase orders in the furtherance of this Resolution. However, any expenditures beyond the original bid of \$87,207.46 shall be subject to further authorization by this Council.

**SECTION III:** The Director of Finance is authorized and instructed to issue such vouchers and expend all funds necessary in the furtherance of this Resolution.

**SECTION IV:**

(a) It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were passed in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

(b) This resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City, and for the further reason that it is necessary to maintain the city-owned properties within the City; wherefore, this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the affirmative vote of five (5) members of Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise this resolution shall be in effect from and after its adoption at the earliest period allowed by law.
