ORDINANCE NO. 25-O-25

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN ADVANCE OF FUNDS FROM THE GENERAL FUND #100 TO THE WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT ROCKWOOD FUND #501, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, it is necessary from time to time to make transfers and advances from various funds to other various funds in order to provide for essential government operations.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Kirtland, County of Lake and State of Ohio, that:

SECTION I. The following advances are hereby authorized and approved in the amounts not to exceed:

ADVANCE FROM FUND ADVANCE TO FUND AMOUNT

General Fund #100 WWTP Rockwood Fund #501 \$25,000.00

SECTION II.

- (a) It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were passed in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- (b) This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City, and for the further reason that such rate schedules are necessary in order to maintain and improve the sanitary sewer package plant facilities within the City of Kirtland; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the affirmative vote of five (5) members of Council and approval by the Mayor. Otherwise this Ordinance shall be in effect from and after its adoption at the earliest period allowed by law.
