ORDINANCE NUMBER 26-O-41

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CREATION OF
THE LAK-KIRTLAND CHARDON RD GRANT FUND NO.
323, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, NOACA has previously granted to the City of Kirtland the sum of \$480,560.00 in accordance with its 2024-2027 Transportation Improvement Program; and

WHEREAS, this Council had passed 25-R-10 which accepted the grant and its accompanying agreement; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Rev. Code 5705.09(F) requires subdivisions to establish separate funds for each class of revenue derived from a source other than the general property tax; and

WHEREAS, Council finds the recommendation of the Administration to establish the LAK-Kirtland Chardon Rd Grant Fund No. 323 to be in compliance with the Revised Code and in accordance with best practices by the Auditor of State.

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRTLAND,
LAKE COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:**

SECTION 1. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to establish the LAK-Kirtland Chardon Rd Grant Fund No. 323 to separately account for any moneys received through NOACA's 2024-2027 Transportation Improvement Program.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of the Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Kirtland, such reason being to authorize the creation of the LAK-Kirtland Chardon Rd Grant Fund No. 323 to separately account for funds received by the City

through NOACA's 2024-2027 Transportation Improvement Program. It shall therefore become effective upon its passage by the affirmative vote of not less than five (5) members of Council and approval by the Mayor or otherwise at the earliest time allowed by law.
