

KIRTLAND CITY COUNCIL MINUTES

November 4, 2020 – Work Session

The work session meeting of Kirtland City Council commenced at 6:02 p.m. Due to the current state of emergency regarding COVID-19, the meeting was held virtually via Zoom.
