

KIRTLAND CITY COUNCIL MINUTES

February 3, 2025 – Work Session

The work session meeting of Kirtland City Council commenced at 6:30 p.m. Council members present were Joseph Smolic, Scott Haymer, Julie Symonds, Ronald Fenstermaker and Matt Schulz.

Mayor Kevin Potter, Matt Lallo, Law Director, City Engineer Douglas Courtney, Service Director, Joe Fornaro, Police Chief Brian McCallister, Fire Chief Tony Hutton and Senior Center Director, Julie DeWolf were also in attendance.

Ms. Wendy Zele, Regional External Affairs for First Energy, was invited to address Council at the work session meeting.
