

KIRTLAND CITY COUNCIL MINUTES

December 1, 2025 – Work Session

The work session meeting of Kirtland City Council commenced at 6:45 p.m. Council members present were Joe Smolic, Eric Zeigler, Ron Fenstermaker, Scott Haymer, Matt Schulz, Sue Grazia and Julie Symonds.

Mayor Kevin Potter, Assistant Law Director Mark Marong, Lieutenant Jamey Fisher, Chief Tony Hutton, City Engineer Doug Courtney, and Senior Center Director Julia DeWolf.

Mayor Potter welcomed Judge Jeffrey R. Ruple to Council chambers. Judge Ruple will be administering the oath of office to the three re-elected Council-at-Large members: Matt Schulz, Eric Zeigler, and Ron Fenstermaker prior to the regular Council meeting.

Council President Fenstermaker noted that Mr. Slapnicker asked that legislation 25-O-72 & 25-R-74 to be considered for passage this evening.

Responding to Mr. Fenstermaker's question about outstanding minutes from Standing Committee meetings; Mr. Marong stated that will have no impact on this evening's legislation 25-R-86.
