

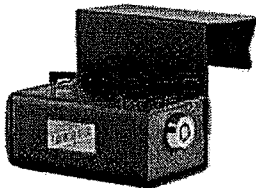

New Lock Box Program

The Kirtland Fire Department has recently implemented a new Roper Lock Box program for its residents. The lock box hangs over your door and has a spare key inside so in case of an emergency the Fire Department can gain entry into your home without any damage to doors or windows. The Fire Department is the only department that has a master key to these boxes. This program is ideal for elderly residents who live alone or have medical alert buttons; and is affordable at a cost of only \$35 each.
